



Albert Lea Knights Baseball – Sponsor Form

The Knights Baseball Club was formed in 2006 to provide youth in Albert Lea and surrounding communities the opportunity to learn and play baseball in a fun and positive environment. The Club is focused on giving youth a chance to develop their baseball skills and knowledge of the game. We also seek to instill the team concept as well as sportsmanship and respect for coaches, umpires, and teammates.

In 2010, the Knights program featured a 9AA team that placed 4th at the MBT State Championships. Our 10AA team placed 2nd at the Gopher State Tournament of Champions and 1st at the MBT State Championships. Our 12AA team placed 1st at the USSSA State Championships and 2nd at the Gopher State Tournament of Champions and traveled to Lenexa, KS for a USSSA World Series event. We were also involved with running the T-Ball and Coach Pitch programs in Albert Lea as well as participating in the adopt-a-park program with the city by adopting Snyder Park and helping to keep it clean and maintained.

For the 2011 season, the Knights Baseball program is planning to field 9 competitive travel teams in age groups from 9 - 13 years old. These teams will play against the best competition in the state of Minnesota and Iowa. We will be hosting our 5th annual Knights Baseball Invitationals on June 18th - 19th and June 25th - 26th. We will be expecting about 30 teams from out of town and these will be State Tournament Qualifiers in 5 different classifications.

The Knights Baseball program relies on player fees, fundraisers, and sponsorships to fund our operations. Our expenses include the cost of uniforms, equipment, umpire fees, field fees, tournament entry fees, and insurance.
